What's New In PULLMAIL?

Takes an email address from standard input. Emails the to address and from the email address specified in the account. The SMTP credentials are taken from the standard credentials ``/etc/ppp/options``. If a custom field is defined that takes precedence over the ``To`` field, it is searched for and used. An option of ``-c`` is provided to specify a custom field to use. This is in addition to the ``To`` field and the ``Apparently-To`` field. Example: ./pullmail -f myname@address.com Example: Pullmail -f myname@address.com -c myfield Example: ./pullmail -c myname -f myname@address.com commands: list all available command-lines ./pullmail -h Usage: ./pullmail [OPTIONS] Pullmail -f -c : [] Pullmail reads a message address (To:, or Apparently-To:) from standard input, emails that address and uses the SMTP credentials stored in ``/etc/ppp/options``. The message is read and the addresses used are stored in the global options variable so that they can be used with other commands like ``sendmail``. --help Display a help message. --version Display version information. This is a drop-in replacement for pullmail, it offers a simple interface with support for standard email headers, optional custom field setting and extensive testing to ensure it functions correctly.
